Treasurers report: End of December account balance \$163,647.60. Additions of \$121,986.78, Subtraction of \$16,984.59 Equipment Fund \$15,769.05. December additions included \$9,000 ach deposit from the State of WI, Rural Fire Signs \$93, Burnett County Election Refund \$1,057.00. Tax collection batch 1- \$84,096.83, Batch 2- \$30,725.63, and \$14.32 Interest. There are still \$28,000 unallocated APRA funds. Tax collection to date: \$301,791.18, which brings us to about 30% collection.
