- The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Melanie Connor Johnson at 6:00 p.m.
- Roll Call of Officers – All present. Clerk Maggie Olson absent. Clerk Olson in at 6:15 p.m.
- Public Notice was made at the Town Hall, Town Shop, and online on 05/10/2026.
- Approval of Agenda Order – Motion by Supervisor Karolyn Kroll, second by Supervisor Ken Pardun to approve the agenda as presented. All in favor, motion carried.
- Approval of Minutes from April 21st, 2026, Regular Meeting – Motion by Supervisor Kroll, second by Supervisor Pardun to approve the minutes. All in favor, motion carried.

- Chair Report – Met with Structural Buildings to talk about Town Hall on Dongola Rd, project will start end of May. One phone call about potholes, one email regarding a tree on Austin Lake Rd. When Roads starts patching, she will post to Facebook to avoid the area for employee safety.
- Clerk Report – Routine bookwork. Payroll check from April did not direct deposit to her account due to closing the bank account, she will bring a paper check to the next meeting for signatures.
- Deputy Clerk Report – Nothing to report.
- Treasurer Report – The Capital Expense Account at Community Bank is \$20,000.85 as of 04/30/2026. The Equipment Fund Balance was \$26,326.96 as of 04/30/2026. The General Fund balance as of 04/30/2026 was \$400,098.68 with total subtractions of \$22,392.60 and total additions of \$39,880.28. The additions were State of WI Transportation Aid in the amount of \$31,394.95, Burnett County Refund for NSF Property Taxes in the amount of \$6,156.92, \$62.00 in dog licenses, \$300.13 from State of WI PILT tax, \$1,949.61 in payroll credit (Olson's returned DD), and interest of \$16.67. She is working with the US Dept of Treasury to gain access to file the SLFRF Report. Motion to accept the report by Supervisor Pardun, second by Supervisor Kroll. All in favor, motion carried.
- Supervisors Reports – Supervisor Kroll has nothing to report. Supervisor Pardun spoke with Roger Tollander re: small parcel on Tollander and Buck and their intent to give the parcel to the Town. Supervisor Pardun will follow up.
- Road Report – Grading, pickup truck fixed (\$11,000.00), picked up patch, roadside clean up. Discussion about town road workers, there has not been responses to work from either part time roads staff member.
